

Assistance for All Souls Families

All Souls Unitarian Church--Community Resource Bank

Definition: Donations of groceries to church members and/or their family members.

Approval Process: An application for assistance will be completed for every request. This application may be completed by the applicant or by the pastoral care minister. All applications will remain confidential. Applications must be reviewed and approved by the pastoral care minister before assistance can be provided. The pastoral care minister may authorize others (e.g., ministers, care team members) to approve requests in his/her absence.

Eligibility: Any member of All Souls Unitarian Church (pledging or non-pledging) is eligible for assistance from the CRB. At the discretion of the pastoral care minister, close associates of church members may also be approved for assistance. Anyone aware of an All Souls family in need should contact the care team or the pastoral care minister.

Frequency: Families may receive assistance once per month. After initial approval, the request should be reevaluated at least once every six months to verify that assistance is still appropriate.
