

COVID update July 7, 2022

Risk Level

MEDIUM

Tulsa County New Cases: 33/100K High

Oklahoma State Hospital: 222 Low

14,600 active cases in OK (up from last month 4,522)

28 pediatric hospitalizations in OK this week (19 the first week in June)

Tulsa Wastewater: North 1.2M, South 844K Tulsa 38% BA.5 OKC 60% BA.5 thru June 23

OK 2022 COVID Mortality Rate: 1.1% (11/1000) 10x that of influenza

- Nationally COVID mortality rate is still 10x that of influenza as of early March

Recommended actions based on current level:

- Stay up to date on COVID-19 vaccinations, second booster is recommended for over 50 and at risk.
- Get tested if you have symptoms or known exposure.
- Wear a mask if you have symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19.
- Choose to wear a mask at any time as an additional precaution to protect yourself and others.
- Wear a mask on public transportation.

Therapeutics:

- **Monoclonal antibodies in short supply – switched again for BA.2**
- Only Monoclonal for BA.5 is Bebtelovimab. OK has 1691 doses
- Paxlovid OK doses - 1388
