MLK Parade Preparation

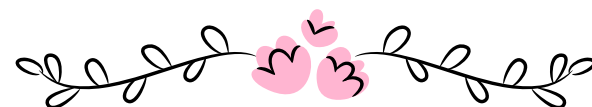

Feeding Our Community

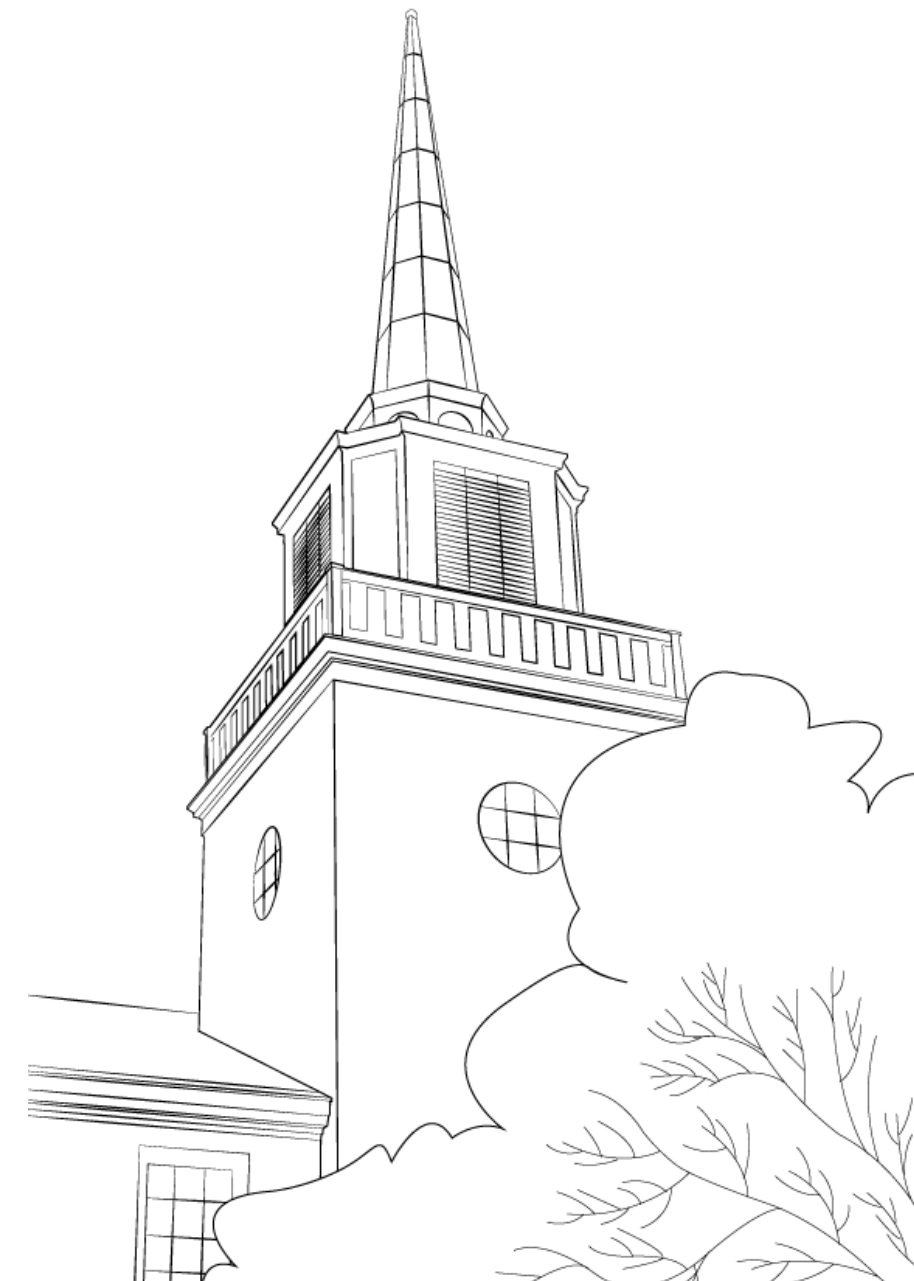
