## Youth Sunday + Art Market | April 26 & 27

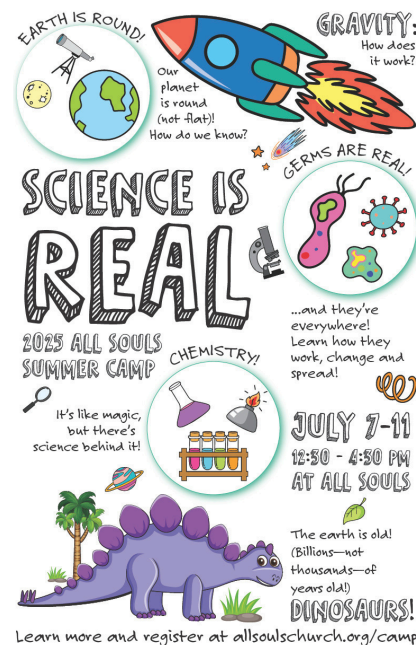
