## Selection of potential recipients by the All Souls Unitarian Church Generosity Committee

The following factors are used in review of all Applications for designation of an offering: Issues identified by the congregation as important:

- Daily needs
- Human rights and equality
- Health
- Arts
- Education
- Environmental Disaster relief
- Individual, Family and Community development
- Spirituality
- Safety (i.e., domestic violence, abuse & neglect)
- Animal welfare

## Church Criteria

- Empower those they serve
- Provide services with dignity
- Provide legitimate and needed services to the public
- Embrace All Souls' vision and mission
- Has accountability to the community through a representative board of directors
- Has a large enough budget to be stable
- Has a track-record and a known history
- Are of a size that a gift will be meaningful
- Are a non-profit organization, usually 501(c)(3)
- The organization's connection to the other sources of significant funding
- Provide All Souls members volunteer opportunities

In addition, the Committee tries to time recommendations based on an organization's focus and services aligned with All Souls Church monthly worship designation or disastrous events.

Organizations are researched before being considered for designation of an offering through: Information provided on the Plate Offering Application and the organization's website; through Charity Navigator, Charity Watch, Give.org, Guidestar and government charity and or tax registration organizations.
